PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The 2018 New England Sports and Orthopedic Rehabilitation Summit will offer learners the opportunity to participate in lectures, interactive panel discussions, and hands-on laboratory style breakout sessions to synthesize and integrate current evidence related to conservative, surgical, and rehabilitation management of various hip pathologies throughout the lifespan. Participants will review key current concepts related to the conservative and post-operative rehabilitation of these hip pathologies to optimize successful functional and post-operative outcomes. Participants will also be offered the opportunity to apply these concepts and improve integration in hands-on breakout sessions.
